## Anti Pass Back at the parking lot

Since June, the anti pass back principle is in operation at the parking lots of Uns40 and Uns50. This means, that entering a parking lot by means of a UMcard, forces you to also use the UMcard when leaving the parking lot. If you do not follow this procedure, you cannot leave or enter the parking lot a next time. As stated, the procedure applies to both entering and leaving the parking lot without presenting your UMcard.

This means that you always have to present your UMcard, even if the barrier is already open.

## Power Interruption 2018 Uns50

The yearly power interruption at Uns50 to test the systems and safety precautions, will take place in June instead of March, starting 2018. Announcements about the exact date will be made in May 2018.

## Power Interruption 2017 November Uns50

In response to the forced power interruption of last June, major alterations have been made to the power systems. These adjustments and alterations need to be tested and some reparations in the power systems in Uns50 need to be done.

November 18 2017 the power of Uns50 will be interrupted several times.

## Computer glasses

## Waste from laboratories

To prevent hazardous situations around (broken and laboratory) glass waste and empty packaging of hazardous chemicals; please make sure to separate this waste category according to the regulations on the waste posters and waste-tool. For safety reasons, glass boxes that are not filled according to the regulations will no longer be emptied.

Also, all disposable (tissue culture) pipettes (contaminated as well as not-contaminated) have to be disposed of in the bins for specific hospital waste. To guarantee the safety of our cleaning staff, disposal in general laboratory waste is not allowed.
