## Reminder Instruction Spill

An instruction on how to handle a major SPILL with chemicals has passed the ARBO Committee UM Randwyck. The SPILL instruction to alarm 1333 is different from the usual procedures because of the special safety measures to be taken. The instruction is to be read at the website CRISP/Safety/Incidents.

## Working in the Fume Hood (zuurkast)

The fume hood is a safety cabinet for working with dangerous chemicals. Handling of low surface tension chemicals, for instance organic solvents, should always take place in the hood. For an ergonomically proper working with the fume hood an instruction is available on Eleum in the section for armico's.

## Ergonomics

The prevention workers/armicos have had an update of the work place instruction, mainly to prevent CANS (Complaints of Arm, Neck or Shoulder) or lower back pain. The instruction is placed on Eleum in the section for armico's.

## Vaccination Hepatitis B and Tetanus

For working with human material, animals and in the function of BHV (emergency assistance), vaccination to Hepatitis B or Tetanus is provided by UM. UM has contracted Ease Travel Clinic & Health Support in azM for the performance of vaccination for employees and students.

## Hazardous substances

For weighing and storage of registered hazardous cytotoxic substances a central facility is available. The facility is located at Uns50 F4.125 and under supervision of Marcel van Herwijnen. The renewed list of classified hazardous substances (carcinogenic, reprotoxic, mutagenic) is available on Eleum in the section for armico's.

## Opening hours buildings and accessibility

The buildings of UM Randwyck are open during office hours from 07.30 till 18.30 hours.

After 18.30 you need the UMcard for access.

All buildings are from Monday till Thursday accessible until 22.00 hours.

At Friday all buildings are closed at 18.30 hours.

In the weekends only Uns50 is open from 12.00 till 17.00 hours.

Some buildings have accessibility with UMcard permit at Saturday from 09.00 till 17.00 hours.

24 hours access can be allowed only at request by the Umcard Form and with the explicit permission of the department chair. The form must be transferred to the reception Uns40.

## Special openings

During carnival, 11 and 12 February, the buildings of UM are closed. Access is permitted for 24 hour authorized personal in Uns40 and 50 and Oxf70. The addresses Dub30, Deb1 (except ground floor), Uns60 have access for authorized personal between 09.00 and 17.00 hours.

## Planned power supply interruption

From Friday 15 March till Sunday 17 March the power supply of Uns50 will interrupted for at least two times. Special notifications shall be send by mail for reminder purposes.
