Christmas trees

For the sake of safety the board of the university has ordered that no natural Christmas trees are allowed in the buildings.

Opening hours and accessibility Christmas 2013 and start 2014

Tuesday December 24 at 5.00 pm the buildings of UM Randwyck will close until Thursday January 2 2014 at 07.30 am. Only Uns40 and 50 are accessible all days with 24h permission. The other buildings are accessible with 24h permission at 27, 30 and 31 December between 09.00 am and 05.00 pm.

Power interruption Uns50 spring 2014

The yearly power interruption test for azM and Uns50 will take place in the morning of Saturday March 22. Please take notice of this fact in the planning of experiences and research. This is not the regular day! Maintenance at the power supply in Uns50 is planned until 06.00 p.m.. This will cause several power interruptions in the southern part of the building (Half zone G and K, whole zone H).

Traffic at Randwyck

Due to construction activities of azM at the Verheylaan the routing of bicyclists and pedestrians will have to change for the next 2 and a half year. Verheylaan will be closed as from December 16. Cyclists are recommended to use Universiteitssingel when coming from North, East and South. When coming from West, we recommend using the cycling path next to Uns40 and use Ten Hoorlaan in between of azM and Uns50. These routes are signposted. Pedestrians from the parking lot of Sorbonnelaan are recommended to use the stairs next to the parking garage of azM and transfer via azM to Uns50.

VivariUM

The Supervisory Council has requested a 'business plan' pertaining to VivariUM. The Faculty has invited Mrs. T. Coenen to give a 'second opinion' about the quality, specifications and size of the planned VivariUM.

Maastrichtzaal

The plaster of the Maastrichtzaal has been damaged. The repairment will take place from December 23 until January 2.

Wifi

Due to increased use of mobile equipment, wifi capacity will be extended in the buildings UM Randwyck. The project will be accomplished March 5 2014.

Laboratory equipment

It is unavoidable that equipment needs maintenance or meets an end to its life cycle. Please be aware that this equipment can be contaminated with dangerous chemical or biological agents. The technicians of IDEE and specialized firms must be sure that the equipment is clean and that they can work safely. Therefore we urge you to set up a procedure for handling over equipment in case of maintenance or end of use.

Admitted hand disinfectants

In the Netherlands, only a limited number of hand disinfectants are permitted for laboratory use. For proper hand hygiene: use a dispenser with Sterilium med (manufacturer: Bode).
