Maintenance of the ventilation system and closing UNS50, June 8:

Revision work on the ventilation UNS50 needs to be done on June 8 (except CPV). Do not plan any experiments in this weekend. The building will be accessible again after 5.00 p.m.

Power interruption UNS 50, June 15:

On Saturday, June 15, at 6.00 a.m. a power interruption is planned in UNS50. This is a consequence of the maintenance/testing of the azM-electrical power plant. This will affect the whole building UNS50. Access to the building is not allowed between 6.00 a.m. and 10.00 a.m. We advise you to switch off all equipment/devices on the preceding Friday afternoon June 15, and do not plan any experiments in this weekend.

Elevator Uns40 Zone C

Starting this fall the elevators in Zone C Uns40 will be dismantled and replaced by new ones. This project will last 7 weeks starting September 2. During the project, one elevator will be available.

Further maintenance 2019

- *Deb1: in June a new cooling machine will be installed (on the roof).*
- *Deb1: exterior painting, replacement and repair of windows. This project will last until October 18.*
- *UNS60: this fall new entrance doors will be made.*
- *UNS60: the warm water service pipes will be replaced starting July 8 until August 9.*
- *UNS5: this summer the elevator will be maintained from July 8 until July 22 and out of order.*
- *UNS50: The exterior of the first floor passages is painted: the main entrance passage starting June 24; the passage between UNS40 and 50 starting July 8. Bicycles that are in the way will be removed.*
- *UNS50: The windows in the laboratories will be cleaned this summer. Cleaning of the laboratory floors is also scheduled this summer. Specific information will follow.*
- *UNS50: The hallways of UNS50 need maintenance. This is done in the evenings this summer between July 22 and August 9. Sections of hallways will be closed then. Specific information will follow.*
- *UNS50: The eyewash bottles in the laboratories (UNS40 also) are end of date and will be replaced this summer.*
- *UNS40: Maintenance of the ventilation system is to start this summer. This will affect the Mensa, lecture halls, education rooms and research rooms. Specific information will follow.*

Lab entrance

Students:

- To work independently in a lab, a proof of professional competence (diploma) is necessary. This means that students/interns are not qualified yet. Therefore student/interns always need to be under supervision during lab work (also outside office hours).

Service and maintenance personnel:

- (External) service and maintenance personnel is not allowed to enter a laboratory on their own. They need to be guided and instructed by the lab manager. For GMO laboratories, the laboratory needs to be released first (using the 'release form' on the CRISP website), before maintenance work can take place.
